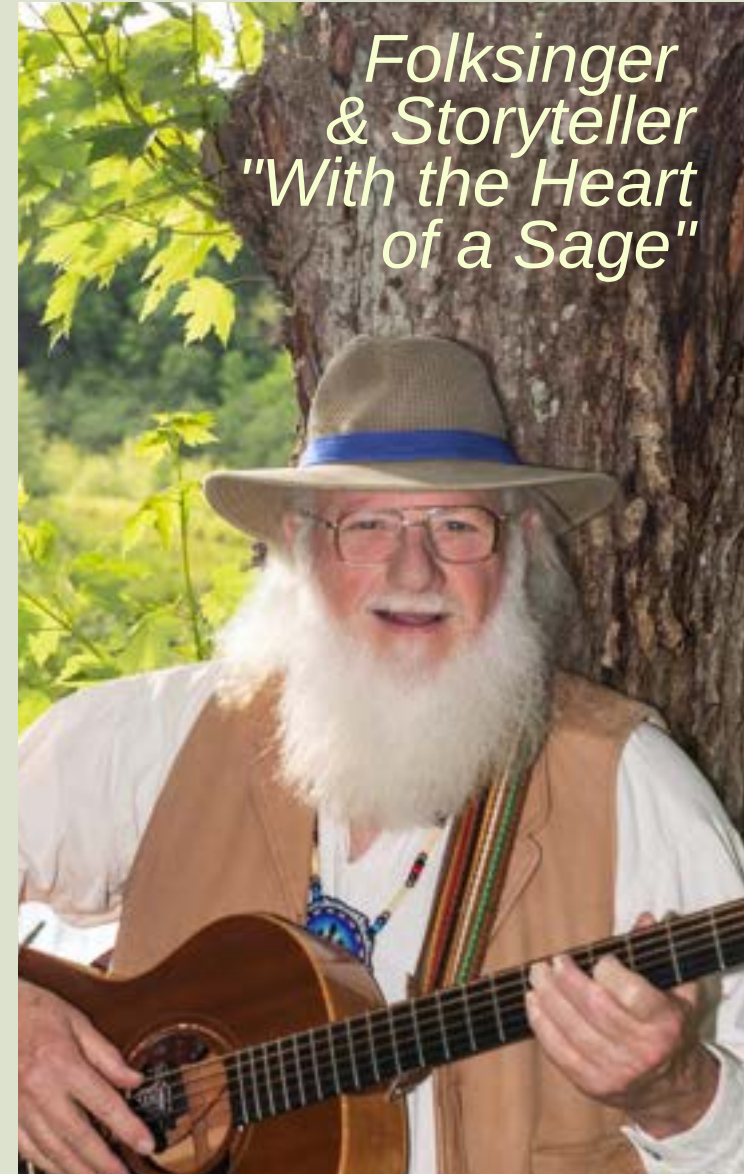

Let's gather soon and raise our voices, hearts, and hands together... sharing common ground, cherishing our differences, and joining in a commitment for a stronger peace-filled world.

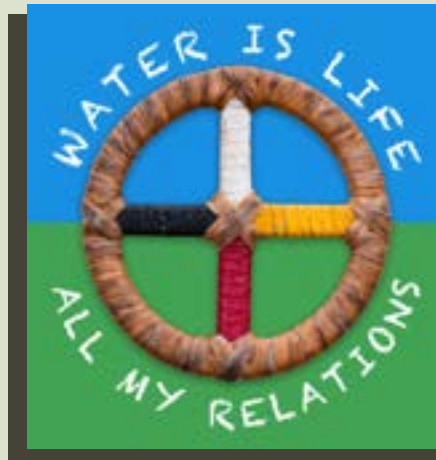

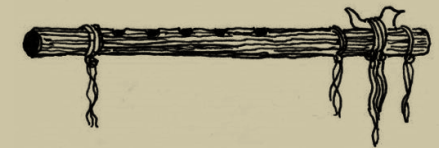
